③ 次の英文は、高校生の勇太が、校内英語スピーチコンテストで発表したときの原稿です。これに関して、あとの1～6に答えなさい。

When something doesn't go well, how do you feel? When you are faced with something difficult, how do you feel? Many of you may feel that you are unlucky. However, you can find something positive if you look at an unlucky situation from a different point of view.

When I was a third-year junior high school student, I was a member of the track and field team, and I was a high jumper. I practiced hard every day, but at the beginning of July, I injured my leg and had to stop practicing. I was because I was not sure that I could join my last competition after two months. I thought, "I cannot practice before my leg gets better. I don't know what to do."

One day, I was looking at my teammates during practice, and Mr. Yamada, the track and field team coach, came to me. I told him how I felt. He said, "I know how you are feeling now. You will need a few weeks to recover, right? You may be thinking that you cannot practice much, but there may be things you can do now to be a better high jumper. ① Why don't you find things you can do now?" After I talked with Mr. Yamada, I wondered what to do, and I started to do some exercises without using my injured leg.

Then, the next day, I wanted to try more things to improve my jump. First, I started to watch the videos of my jump carefully. Before I injured my leg, I did not watch the videos very much. This time, I carefully watched the videos, and ② I (things I that should found) improve. Then, I thought about how to improve them. Before I injured my leg, I always asked Mr. Yamada what training I should do and did it without thinking much. However, I realized that I should understand the purpose of each training to improve my jump. I used my time to understand it, and made plans for the training I should do after I fully recovered.

After three weeks, I recovered, and I started practicing with my teammates again. When I practiced, I remembered the purpose of each training, and I found that some kinds of training were more effective than before. My jump started to get better.

In September, the day of my last competition came. I was able to jump 1.60 meters, 1.65 meters and 1.70 meters. Finally, I tried 1.73 meters. I took a deep breath and jumped. I did it! It was my best jump. I was able to break my best record.

When things don't go well, you may feel unlucky. I felt unlucky when I injured my leg. However, because I injured my leg, I was able to find different ways to improve my jump.

So, I can say that I was lucky to injure my leg. In this way, if you look at an unlucky situation from a different point of view, you can find something that will make you lucky. So, if you are faced with a difficult situation, remember my story, and look at the situation from a different point of view. I am sure it will help you find something that will bring luck to you.
